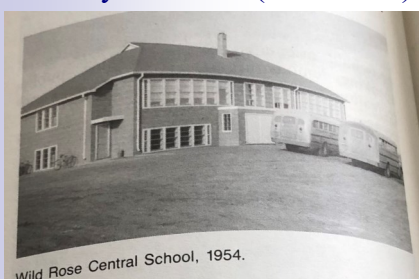

In 1953, Jim Irving, Chairman of the Prince Albert Rural School Unit, called a meeting to consider building a centralized school. A four classroom school was to be built to accommodate Grades 1 to 12 students from Briarlea East and West, Nisbet, Sturgeon Valley, Brant and Crystal Plains (Wild Rose).
