3. Approval of Previous Minutes

Dana Steward made a motion to approve the previous meeting minutes. The motion was seconded by Lynn Wood. Motion carried.

4. Principal's Report

- The Walkathon fundraiser has been successful in past years, with all funds directly supporting students.
- Staff Appreciation Week is scheduled for February 9–13, 2026.
- The Remembrance Day Ceremony was very well attended.
- The basketball season is nearing completion, with the Extravaganza scheduled for next week. Miss Hattum and Mrs. Beaven served as coaches this year, and student skill development has been noted.
- The badminton season will be starting soon.
- The EA Rawlinson Centre play and the Christmas Dinner were both successful events. Appreciation was extended to the SCC for their support.
- Miss Hattum's class organized donation collections for the homeless and women's shelters prior to the Christmas break.
- Family Literacy Week will take place next week. All families are invited to attend from 5:00–6:30 pm.
- The school year calendar for the upcoming year has been released.
- A \$27,602 grant for new playground equipment has been approved. The application was submitted in October 2025, with approval received in December 2025.

- Tracy Bloomquist worked with three student groups, with the majority agreeing that the target age group for new playground equipment should be Grades 4 and up.
- Several playground equipment options have been identified. SRPSD will determine final selections based on cost effectiveness.
- Playground equipment installation is planned for the summer.
- Upcoming school events include: report cards issued January 28; PLC day with no classes on January 30; no school February 16–20; progress conferences March 12; no school March 13; Easter Break April 3–10; no classes May 15; Victoria Day May 18; Camp Cadash June 17–18; BP lunches on January 23, February 27, and May 22.

5. Trustee Report

- A meeting was held with the City of Prince Albert.
- Topics discussed included student safety and transportation.
- A public section meeting was also conducted.
- Teacher shortages continue to be a concern.
- Absenteeism remains an issue, with rates reported as 13% in rural schools, 31% in urban schools, and 10% at Wild Rose.
- Canwood School received a grant for new playground equipment.
- Parents are encouraged to attend SCC meetings to participate in discussions regarding funds raised.

6. Transportation

- Jerrold Pidborochynski and Ryan Bruce attended the meeting to discuss proposed transportation changes, including adjusted start and end times and the elimination of a bus route.
- The proposed new school start time is 8:10 am, with dismissal at 2:45 pm.
- A final decision is expected by the end of March.

- The next SCC meeting is scheduled for March 31, 2026 at 6:00 pm.
